They allow you to: - Access secure areas of the site - Log in to your account or online learning portal - Make purchases or enrol in courses You cannot disable these cookies through our website as they are essential to its operation. Performance and Analytics Cookies These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website — for example, which pages are most popular or how long users spend on a page. We may use tools such as Google Analytics to gather anonymous usage statistics that help improve our services. Functionality Cookies These cookies allow our website to remember your preferences (such as login details or language settings) to provide a more personalised experience. Marketing and Social Media Cookies If we use marketing or social media integrations (such as Facebook Pixel, Instagram embeds, or email tracking), these cookies help us show relevant promotions or content. You will be notified and may consent to these cookies where applicable.

3. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be set by third-party services used on our website, such as: - Stripe – for secure payment processing - Google Analytics – for site traffic analysis - Social media integrations – for sharing or login features These third parties have their own privacy and cookie policies, which we encourage you to review.

You can manage or disable cookies through your web browser settings. Most browsers allow you to: - Block all cookies - Delete existing cookies - Receive notifications before a cookie is stored Please note: disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of our website, including course access or checkout processes.
